



PROGRAM PERKS FOR STUDENTS



FULL DESCRIPTIONS

GUIDED ONLINE TUTORING

Our guided online tutoring program allows elementary and middle school students to advance through the Common Core math curriculum at their level and individual pace. High school students will have access to an ACT prep curriculum. A minimum of one hour per week is required. Each student will be assigned a learning coach who will set up an appointment to administer a diagnostic assessment to the student. Based on the assessment results, the coach will create a personalized, online study plan. Students will then complete weekly assignments and receive weekly feedback and email support from their coach. Through the parent portal, parents can access their child's live results and progress..

LOCAL MEETUPS

Opportunities to find friends and share experiences will be offered through a combination of outings in the community and program sponsored events. Local meetups are optional but encouraged and will be planned monthly.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Service learning gives kids an authentic educational experience while teaching empathy. Students will find their own creative opportunities to serve and learn and submit their monthly service log for prizes and incentives!

CODING EXPLORERS

Do you have a student at home who enjoys spending time on the computer or could play Minecraft for hours?

Coding Explorers is the place to take that interest in technology, and turn it into a productive skill. Designed for boys and girls in elementary school who want to try out programming, Coding Explorers is a fun way to learn to code in a social, after-school setting. Students are taught to code using popular coding curriculum. No prior programming experience is required, but students should be comfortable using a mouse, keyboard, and web browser.

This course serves students in grades 3 thru 5.

WEB DESIGN SQUAD

This is a project-based course that teaches students how to build their own web pages. Students will learn the languages HTML and CSS, and will create their own live homepages to serve as portfolios of their creations. Students will finish this course with tangible, professional, mobile responsive websites. No prior programming experience is required, but students should be comfortable using a mouse, keyboard, and web browser.

This course serves students in grades 6 thru 12.
